PEOPLE OF KAUWERAK: Legends of the Northern Eskimo author published by the AMU Press. Collected by the late William A. Oquilluk over a 60-year period, the legends and stories of this book have been transmitted orally from generation to generation for thousands of years.

Oquilluk is the first to gather

homeland for his people.

Like the Old Testament,
"People of Kauwerak" is a varied and inspired literature, with heroes for every disaster, with instruction on "the way it was

and why we do what we do," with love stories, adventure stories, and-through it all-high

ideals for community life.

It is by no means, however, an Eskimo imitation of Hebraic-

Christian scripture.

Frost says, "It is exciting to realize that here in our lifetime in our state, a modest and unassuming Eskimo gentleman has fulfilled the same function for his people that Homer fulfilled for the ancient Greeks.
