CURTAIL WASTEFUL HERRING HARVESTING

JUNEAU-The Board of Fish and Game has taken action to curtail the wasteful practice of harvesting herring for the single purpose of extracting roe.

In a policy adopted at its recent meeting in Juneau, the board directed the Department of Fish and Game to manage Alaska's limited herring resources in a manner that will permit their fullest utilization as food and bait.

Carl Rosier, director of the department's commercial fisheries division, said that the board established limited quotas for the Kodiak, Cook Inlet, Prince William Sound and Southeastern sac roe fisheries in 1974.
