be entered. Original works of
art are eligible; no copies or
kitwork will be accepted; recept way; in professor Fra-

kitwork will be accepted; recent work is preferred. Entries to be shipped should be packed securely in a strong wooden box. Final judging for the "traveling" centennial Art Exhibit will be done in Juneau in October, di strict pre-judging will be done in each district

in September.

The show will begin its journey from Juneau in January 1967 and be on view in Fairbanks in August 1967.
