

# "Wood as Fuel" booklet available

JUNEAU, Alaska — Alaskans have always been large users of firewood. Now, a free booklet is available that tells what species of wood are the best to use for fuel. It also suggests how to harvest wood, how to season it, and how wood heat costs compare with fuel oil.
