Two killed, one injured in Pt. Hope Blast

An explosion at the National Guard Armory in Point Hope on October 24 killed Gilbert Howarth, Junior, and Ashley Long, and seriously injured a third man, Don Lane. Howarth and Lane were both members of Point Hope's Bravo Company of the Third Scout Battalion of the National Guard. Long was a civilian.

According to Scout headquarters in Kotzebue, the blast occurred as stove oil was being transferred from drums to a storage tank at the Armory.
