OBJECTIVE: To conduct intensive archaeological field surveys, oral histories, literary and archive research to locate all possible cultural, historical, and archeological remains within BSNC's remaining and ineligible Historic and Cemetery Sites and prepares final report(s) in determining Site significance and eligibility for possible conveyance under section 14 (h) (1) of ANSCA.

Minimum Qualifications: Master's degree in anthropology with course emphasis in archaeology. Minimum of two field seasons experience in archaeology site location, identification, and excavation. Extensive report writing experience, and field survey. One field seasons work must have been in a supervisory capacity. Knowledge of the BSNA region. Extensive knowledge of Federal laws and regulations pertaining to ANSCA Section 14 (h) (1). Field experience with Bachelor degree may be considered in lieu of Master's degree. - 2) Compiles, maintains, and develops a computerized ANSCA 14(h) (1) data base to include transfer of 14 (h) (1) data to State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO).

3) Provides in house training to field assistant (s) in carrying out program duties.

4) Responsible for all logistical planning to carry out program goals and objectives.

5) Carries out proper field procedures using tools such as transits, compasses, tapes, cameras, etc.

6) Conducts extensive library and archive research on site areas prior to, during and after field work to compile data for use in field planning, analysis and report writing.

7) Conducts extensive oral histories associated with field sites.

8) Prepares program budgets, quarterly and year end reports.

Activity: The Wainwright Fuel Services Tank Farm is operated by Eskimos, Inc. The operations are conducted in the State of Alaska and involve supplying diesel and unleaded gasoline in Wainwright. To support their operations they operate bulk fuel storage tanks whose capacity exceeds

42,000 gallons. Facilities of this type are potential sources of large fuel spills. To prevent or minimize the possibility of a discharge and to ensure that the facility is capable of cleaning up a fuel spill should one occur, the facility is required to have an Oil Discharge Prevention and Contingency Plan.
