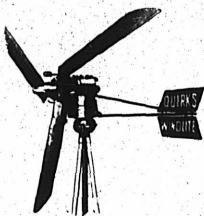

Sealed bids in single copy for furnishing all labor, materials and equipment, and performing all work on Project S-9999(3), Interior District Resigning (Secondary) described herein, will be received until 2:00 p.m. prevailing time January 9, 1975 in the Commissioner's Office, Department of Highways, Island Center Building, Douglas, Alaska.

This project will consist of furnishing and placing approximately 4,132 square feet of standard signs on all secondary highways in the Interior District. The signs replacement work will extend from the Taylor Highway east to all secondary routes feeding westerly and northerly out of Fairbanks, Alaska. Also included in the work will be the installation of 240 State Furnished Milepost Signs. All posts and mounting hardware, for installing the State Furnished Milepost signs, shall be furnished by the Contractor.

All work shall be completed in 100 Calendar days.

Plans and specifications may be obtained by all who have a bona fide need for them for bidding purposes from the Chief Road Design Engineer, P.O. Notice is hereby given that the Alaska State Medical Board, under authority vested by AS 08.64.100 & 107, proposes to adopt regulations in Title 12 of the Alaska Administrative Code to implement AS 08.64.107 as follows:

Title 12 Chapter 40 is amended as follows:

Adopt new regulations regarding the registration of physician assistants and the medical services they may perform, including the educational and other qualifications, the application and registration procedures, the scope of activities authorized, and the responsibilities of the supervising or training physician.

Notice is also given that any person interested may present oral or written statements or arguments relevant to the action proposed at a hearing to be held in the Conference Room of Fairbanks Memorial Hospital, 1650 Cowles Street, Fairbanks, Alaska at 1:30 o'clock p.m. on December 9, 1974.

Interested persons unable to attend the public hearing may send statements relevant to the action proposed to the State Medical Board, Pouch D, Juneau, Alaska 99811, not later than December 2, 1974.
