

State Accepting Trainees for Practical Nurses

James O'Rourke, Manager of the Fairbanks Office of the Alaska State Employment Service, indicates that they are presently accepting applications from individuals who are interested in becoming Licensed Practical Nurses.

The one-year course will begin June 26 at Anchorage.

All of the trainees must have at least 10th grade education and possess the necessary aptitudes and interests for working as a Licensed Practical Nurse. Applicants should be at least 17½ years of age. Graduates will be eligible for Licensure by the State Board of Nurses upon satisfactory completion the course and examination. Priority in selection will be given to heads of families and MDTA allowances will be available to most applicants.
