
2 Vill. Airports Allocated

Alaskan Airports at Chignik and Kotzebue have been allocated an additional \$536,333 in Federal Aviation Administration Airport Development Aid Program (ADAP) funds to complete airport projects at the two sites, FAA Alaskan Region Director Lyle K. Brown announced recently.

Chignik Airport received \$324,672 for land acquisition, development and clear zones, reconstruct and extend Runway 19-01, construct taxiway, apron and entrance road, and a segmented circle and wind cone. The project was begun in 1974 and now brings the total project allocations to \$699,672.

The Ralph Wien Memorial Airport at Kotzebue was allocated an additional \$211,661 in ADAP funds to convert the existing snow removal equipment (SRE) building into a crash/fire/rescue building and to construct a new SRE building.

The funds for the project which began in 1973 now total \$318,750.
