

VA Manager Is Appointed At Juneau

Howard C. Christie, 52, who for more than ten years has been adjudication officer at the Veterans Administration regional office at Juneau, Alaska, has been appointed manager of that office.

He will replace John C. Denny who is being transferred to the VA central office in Washington, D.C. where he will serve as an assistant area field director. The effective date of the move will be announced later.

Christie received his LL.B. degree from Columbus University law school, Washington, D.C. in 1942 and after World War II attended Seattle University.

He served in the U.S. Navy from July, 1943 to January, 1946 and from September, 1950 to September, 1952 attaining the rank of Lieutenant.

Christie joined the VA at Seattle as an adjudicator in 1946 and served in that office and Alaska until his promotion as manager of VA activities in the 49th state.
