The school board of the Lower Yukon School District met in Pilot Station, Alaska on August 22, 1995. The meeting was held at the high school and began at 11:10 a.m.

The Board took the following actions:

- * Approved the June 9, 1995 minutes.

- * Approved the June, 1995 ex-

penditure ratification report.

- * Approved the July, 1995 expenditure ratification report.

- * Awarded a bid to Office Products Services for a Lanier 6483 copier in the amount of \$24675.00.

- * Approved the purchase of an IBM advanced system 236 computer system to update the current District IBM system

to upgrade the current District IBM system 36, in the amount of 30,000.00.

- * Approved the 1997 C.I.P. application requesting monies for the new school construction at Pilot Station, Kotlik, Sheldon Point and major maintenance monies for Hooper Bay.

- * Approved a Memorandum

of Agreement with Asa'carsarmuit Tribal Council in Mountain Village re: education services provided by the District.

- * Approved funds for school travel to the 1995 A.F.N. Youth and Elders Conference in Anchorage on October 16-18, 1995.

- * Assigned four board members to attend training sponsored by the As-

sociation of Alaska School Boards.

- * Approved a request for early preschool entry at Russian Mission.

- * Scheduled a Board Retreat at Unalakleet for October 24-25-26, 1995.
