

National Guardsmen build a road for Metlakatla

The village of Metlakatla received an extra bonus from National Guardsmen on their two-week annual training on Annette Island over the past few weeks.

A National Guard engineering unit from Haines built a 2,300 foot road which the city said it needed to open up a community program for 42 new building lots. Metlakatla had received a roads and trails grant of \$50,000 to rent some heavy equipment and hire local residents to work with the Guards-

men.

The Haines unit built the 38-foot wide road in about 10 days and Metlakatla city planners said the city hoped to start immediately on the housing development project.
