

New Manager Named

SEATTLE—John W. Titus, Alaska Steamship Company agent at Fairbanks, Alaska, has been named manager of the Lomen Division of the Line with headquarters at Nome, and Martin J. Nusbaum, assistant agent at Fairbanks, has been named to replace Titus. J. F. Zumdieck, vice president and general manager, announced last week.

Both appointments are effective December 1.

John Titus is a graduate of the University of Washington school of business with a major of water transportation. He came to Fairbanks in 1954.
