

Applications asked for Howard Rock scholarships

Applications for scholarships, internships and travel grants are now being accepted for the Howard Rock Scholarship Fund.

The Howard Rock Scholarship Fund was established to commemorate the contributions of artist and journalist Howard Rock, who founded and edited the Tundra Times until his death in 1976.

The Fund is intended to encourage Alaska Native students to enter the field of journalism, including business operations, and to assist non-Native students who have a demonstrated interest in journalism and Native affairs.

Students enrolled at any campus of the University of Alaska are eligible for awards through the fund.

Scholarships are open to first

year Native students who have apparent potential for work in journalism and may be renewed by the scholarship fund committee, if recommended by the student's journalism advisor. Maximum amount for scholarships is \$250 each semester.

Internships are open to full-time students to provide them up to 20 hours weekly work experience on the Tundra Times. Students would be enrolled in Journalism 497 (individual study) or other appropriate course for up to three hours credit. Maximum amount for internships is \$300 each month, which may or may not be supplemented by the Tundra Times.

Applicants for scholarships and internships should apply through a letter of request to Professor Jimmy Bedford, head

of the Department of Journalism and Broadcasting, University of Alaska, Fairbanks, Alaska 99701 describing the applicant's interest and/or experience in journalism, and should furnish a copy of the letter to the President, Alaska Native Foundation, 411 West Fourth, Anchorage, Alaska 99501.

Applicants for travel grants should write the Editor, Tundra Times, Box 1287, Fairbanks, Alaska 99707 proposing a specific story or photo idea. A copy of the letter should be submitted to Professor Bedford, who is required to approve the project for course work.

Applicants for Summer 1978 internships are acted upon as received. The deadline for applications for scholarships and internships for the Fall term is October 1, 1978.
