ALASKA AGRICULTURAL ACTION COUNCIL REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL TO RECEIVE LOAN FUNDS TO CONSTRUCT A LIVESTOCK PROCESSING FACILITY(IES)

The Office of the Governor, Alaska Agricultural Action Council (AAAC), is requesting proposals from parties interested in building, owning, and operating a facility(ies) to buy, slaughter and process livestock, and sell meat and by-products in Alaskan markets. The AAAC is authorized to loan up to \$2.6 million for constructing this facility(ies). Proposal requirements and loan applications can be obtained from the above address in person or by writing.
