

Sheffield visit

Bill Sheffield, Democratic candidate for governor, will travel to Barrow, Kotzebue, Nome and Unalakleet this coming week to meet with voters.

Sheffield's tour has not been finalized but stops so far include Barrow on Tuesday, Oct. 5, where he will appear at a no-host luncheon at Pepi's Mexican restaurant and then hold a public meeting before holding another meeting with officials of the Arctic Slope Regional Corporation.

Later that day he will travel to Kotzebue where he will appear at a reception hosted by Judge Paul Jones.

On Wednesday, Oct. 6, Sheffield will travel to Nome where he will meet with leaders of local and regional Native Corporations.

On Oct. 7, he will travel to Unalakleet, Gambell and Savoonga before returning to Anchorage.
