NOTICE TO THE VOTERS OF ATOASUK

An election will be held in Atqasuk on October 5, 1982 to determine whether:

- 1) the voters desire incorporation of a second class city;
- the voters authorize the levy of a two percent (2%) sales tax; the incorporation of Atqasuk is conditioned upon the authorization of the sales tax proposition;
- if incorporation is approved, the election of the initial seven person council.

Any person who is a qualified voter in Alaska and is a resident of the area of the proposed city for 30 days is qualified to vote in the election.
