

Bill Asks Funds for Radio Facilities at Barrow, Others

Senator Willie Hensley (D-Kotzebue) has introduced Senate Bill 85 along with Senators Sackett, Croft, Hohman, Poland and Meland.

The Bill provides for the appropriation of funds for the construction of radio facilities in Barrow, Dillingham, Kodiak and Petersburg.

The bill would also provide for operational funds for the Southcentral Educational Television facility authorized last year and funds for the development of program materials for

the Tanana Chiefs' Region.

Senator Hensley stated that "It is through the use of radio and other media that Alaskan

society will become more closely knit and aware of the happenings throughout the state and the nation."
