JUNEAU—The Board of Fish and Game will meet in Anchorage on April 12 to consider certain commercial fishing regulation changes.

Public hearings on the king crab regulations, Kodiak scallop seasons and providing subdistricts in the Cook Inlet gillnet districts will begin at 1:30 p.m. on April 12 at the Anchorage Westward Hotel.

Copies of proposed regulation changes may be obtained from Department of Fish and Game offices throughout the state.

Interested persons may present written and/or oral comments on the proposed changes at the public hearing. The public is urged to submit comments on commercial fishing proposals prior to March 29 so that they may be summarized for full consideration by the Board of Fish and Game.

Written testimony will be received up until the public hearing but adherence to the March 29 deadline will allow the board more time to give full attention to each public comment.
