

Committee to Hold Hearings on Higher Education Bills

The Health, Welfare and Education Committee will hold hearings March 10 in Anchorage on proposed Higher Education Legislation as follows:

House Bills - 529, 535, 603, 604, 605, 606, 607, 608, 609.
House Concurrent Resolutions - 19 through 26.

House Joint Resolution - 106.
Senate Bill - 357.

The hearing will be held at the University of Alaska, Anchorage in the East Room of the Lucy Cuddy Campus Center from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. and from 7 p.m. to 9 p.m.

The hearings are open to the public and those wishing to testify may contact the Health, Wel-

fare and Education Committee in Juneau or the Legislative Information Offices in Anchorage or Fairbanks and register to testify.

Testimony for the hearings should be submitted in writing to the Committee Staff during the hearing prior to testifying.

Witnesses should limit their testimony to 15 minutes.

National Parks Centennial Postage Stamp Honors McKinley Park

Design of a postage stamp in the National Parks Centennial series honoring Mt. McKinley has been announced.

According to Fairbanks Postmaster Helen Bell the first day of issue will be July 28, 1972 at McKinley Park, Alaska.

The McKinley stamp will be commemorative-size picturing Mt. McKinley, and will be 15 cent denomination.

First day cancellation requests

for the stamp should be postmarked no later than July 28 and addressed to Mt. McKinley Stamp Postmaster, McKinley Park AK 99755, with remittance of 15 cents each.

Other stamps in the National Parks Centennial series Yellowstone Park, March 2; Cape Hatteras, N.C. on April 5 as well as stamps commemorating City of Refuge, Hawaii and Wolf Trap Farm Park, Virginia.
