

National Parks Centennial Postage Stamp Honors McKinley Park

Design of a postage stamp in the National Parks Centennial series honoring Mt. McKinley has been announced.

According to Fairbanks Postmaster Helen Bell the first day of issue will be July 28, 1972 at McKinley Park, Alaska.

The McKinley stamp will be commemorative-size picturing Mt. McKinley, and will be 15 cent denomination.

First day cancellation requests

for the stamp should be postmarked no later than July 28 and addressed to Mt. McKinley Stamp Postmaster, McKinley Park AK 99755, with remittance of 15 cents each.

Other stamps in the National Parks Centennial series Yellowstone Park, March 2: Cape Hatteras, N.C. on April 5 as well as stamps commemorating City of Refuge, Hawaii and Wolf Trap Farm Park, Virginia.
