The Commercial Fisheries Entry Commission is reminding all Southeast Alaska red/blue and brown king crab and Tanner crab pot fishermen that the deadline for submitting applications is Saturday.

Individuals who commercially participated as gear operators in any of these fisheries prior to 1984 are eligible to apply. Forms can be obtained from Alaska Department of Fish and Game offices in Southeast or directly from the commission at Box KB, Juneau 99811; or by calling 586-3456 in Juneau.

To be considered, an entry permit application must be postmarked or received by the commission on or before Saturday, with an affidavit showing "good cause" if it was not submitted on time.

Those who do not submit an application at this time cannot receive a permit from the Entry Commission.
