Mobile office starts tour

WASHINGTON — The Alaska Congressional Delegation's mobile office will begin its visit through Southcentral Alaska on June 29.

During the week of June 29 through July 3, the mobile office will stop in Eagle River, Chugiak, Palmer, Sutton, Glennallen, Gakona, Paxon and Delta Junction.

The office, which is operated by staff members from Washington, D.C., offices of Sens. Ted Stevens and

Frank Murkowski and Congressman Don Young, is a converted passenger van marked with signs.

"Our mobile office staff will be available to talk with Alaskans who have problems with the federal government or questions about issues facing Congress," said Stevens. "They will also be prepared to meet informally with community groups upon request and to attend community activities which occur during the visit," he added.
