

# 73rd Annual Convention held in Klawock by Alaska Native Brotherhood/Sisterhood

Klawock, Alaska on the Prince of Wales Island was chosen for this year's 73rd annual convention of the Alaska Native Brotherhood and Alaska Native Sisterhood. The meeting, held last Sunday, attracted over 200 delegates.

The four-day meeting in the Southeast Alaska community covered over 80 issues. Topics of discussion

ranged from calling for the establishment of a burn unit at the Mt. Edgecumbe Hospital, to issues of subsistence, habitat protection and ANCSA. ANB spokesman Ron Williams said that a majority of the time during the four days was spent on educational issues. A presentation, "The Educational Philosophy of the Southeast Alaska Natives" was featured during the convention.
