ARCO awards contract for Lisburne construction

ANCHORAGE, AK., April 11 – An Anchorage union contractor, Price /CIRI, has won a contract from AR-CO Alaska, Inc. for module installation work at the new Lisburne oil field on the North Slope.

The contract, announced today by Lee Nunn, ARCO's construction manager, includes interconnection of new modules and connection of power lines at several drill sites. The Lisburne oil field is expected to go into production this fall.

The award, valued at approximately \$4 million, was awarded on a competitive basis.

Price/CIRI has pledged to hire 90 percent including seven percent Native Alaskans.

Construction work is expected to be completed by mid-July.
