

Aleutian military bases featured in museum's historical program

In celebration of Historic Preservation Week, the Alaska State Historic Preservation Office has organized a free public program at the Anchorage Museum of History and Art on Wednesday, May 14 at 7:00 p.m.

In keeping with the theme "Celebrate Our Historic Places: Our Past is Our Future," the evening program will feature a tour of **Alaskan Military Bases in the Aleutians: Forty Years Later**, including several seldom-visited, former WW II bases, with special attention to the facilities at Dutch Harbor. The presentation which will include slides of the bases today, historic photographs and drawings will be presented by Dr. Colt D. Denfeld, Project Historian for the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers; Mr. Robert Spude, Regional Historian for the National Park Service; and Mr. Paul W. Chattey, Architectural Historian for the Alaska State Historic Preservation Office.
