

Limited Entry

Due to the unexpected openings for commercial salmon fishing in the Bristol Bay area, interim-use permits required under Alaska's new limited entry law will be issued on an emergency basis directly by the Department of Fish and Game field offices at King Salmon and Dillingham.

The Commercial Fisheries Entry Commission announced this exception to its policy of issuing permits only from Juneau "because of the hardships that would result to people who might otherwise fish now in a region that has been declared a national disaster area."

This exception applies only to Bristol Bay and only during the emergency order period.
