

# Republicans Offer Support to FNA

Republicans on the Central District Committee last week offered their support to the Fairbanks Native Association's drive to acquire more

and better education facilities for Native youth in the Interior.

The Central District Committee unanimously passed the following resolution at its regular monthly meeting:

"Central District Republicans endorse the concept of including rural youth into local school systems.

"Since the state has full responsibility for the education program of all youth in the state, and after many years of neglect by the State of Alaska, we recommend that the State assume this responsibility and that the State work closely with local school administrations in the programming of curriculum and activities of the students who would be brought into organized district school systems."

The Central District Committee agreed to urge similar endorsement of the education proposal by the State Republican Committee meeting in Juneau March 4 and 5.

Officers of the Central District Committee represent election districts 13, 14, 15 and 16.
