WASHINGTON—Senator Bartlett announced the appointment of an executive committee for the St. Michael's Cathedral National Fund Drive.

Senator Bartlett is chairman of a national campaign to raise funds to rebuild St. Michael's Cathedral in Sitka, Alaska. The cathedral, believed to be the oldest church in Alaska and the finest ex-

ample of Russian architecture in this country, was destroyed by fire on January 2.

Named to the executive committee were: Henry W. Clark, vice president of the Alaska Steamship Company, Mrs. Victor Fischer, a former resident of Anchorage, now living in Chevy Chase, Maryland, and George Hall, park planner with the National Park Service in Washington.
