

# *National Guard In Nome Holds 5-Day Seminar*

NOME—Last week the Alaska National Guard held a five-day seminar for patrol leaders here in Nome.

A representative from each village having a National Guard unit, 32 in all, attended.

During the seminar, every phase of the battalion's operation was discussed, with particular emphasis placed on communications and intelligence.

The planned reorganization of the Scout Battalion was also outlined during the seminar. This new organizational concept is based on separate five-man teams.

Major William Caldwell, Commanding Officer of the 1st Scout Bn, stated that the new organization lends itself well to the widely scattered village units and their mission of gathering intelligence information in support of US Army Alaska.
