

# GRANT FOR METROPOLITAN PLANNING

JUNEAU — Governor William A. Egan announced that the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) has approved a grant of \$482,000 for statewide, local and non-metropolitan planning for the State of Alaska, under the Comprehensive Planning Assistance program.

These funds will be matched by \$215,000 in funds from the State and from local communities.

The revenues will provide funds to the State for furthering statewide planning studies and also includes funds providing grants-in-aid to local communities for municipal planning

and management projects.

Recipients of a share of the funds are the City and Borough of Sitka, the City of Nome, the City of Unalaska, the North Slope Borough, the Fairbanks North Star Borough, the Bristol Bay Borough, Kodiak Island Borough, and the City and Borough of Juneau.
