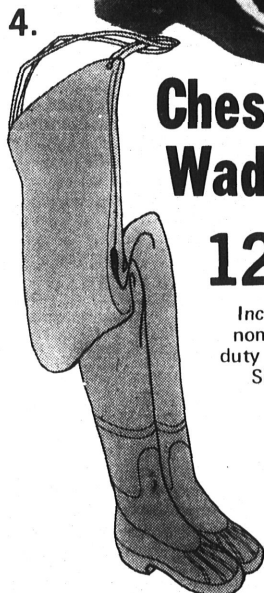

Late Bulletin: New Charges Against ANMC

The Public Health Service Survivor's Committee filed new charges against Alaska Native Medical Center. Four or five native women claim IUD's (Inter-uterine birth control devices) were implanted in them without their knowledge or permission.

Charges may also include testimony that a 16 year old girl was aborted without her permission, and that medical experimentation may have been taking place at ANMC using Alaska natives as subjects, again without their knowledge or permission. Details will appear in next week's Tundra Times.
