

Bristol Bay's Corporations

DILLINGHAM — Bristol Bay Native Corporation officials say 23 villages within that region have been certified as village corporations and they are waiting now for the remaining six villages to submit final drafts of articles of incorporation.

Bristol Bay villages that have received certificates of incorporation from the state of Alaska to date include:

Aleknagik (Aleknagik Natives Limited); Chignik Lake (Chignik River Limited); Egegik (Becharof Corporation); Ekuik (Ekuik

Natives Limited); Ekwok (Ekwok Natives Limited); Igiugig (Igiugig Native Corporation); Kokhanok (Kokhanok Native Corporation); Manokotak (Manokotak Natives Limited); New Stuyahok (Stuyahok Limited); Nondalton (Nondalton Native Corporation); Pilot Point (Pilot Point Native Corporation); Portage Creek (Ohgsenakale Corporation); Port Heiden (Meshik Inc.); Twin Hills (Twin Hills Native Corporation); Ugashik (Ugashik Native Corporation); Chignik (Far West Inc.); Levelock

(Levelock Natives Limited); Naknek (Paug-vik Inc.); Perryville (Oceanside Corporation); South Naknek (Qinuyang Limited); and Togiak (Togiak Natives Limited).

Village corporations still to be certified include Chignik Lagoon, Iliamna, Ivanof Bay, Koliganik, Newhalen, and Pedro Bay. Upon arrival of their documents, all villages within Bristol Bay region will be incorporated as profit-making corporations.
