

Chugachmiut signs agreement

Chugachmiut, the regional tribal organization serving the Chugach Natives, signed a Memorandum of Understanding with the Chugach National Forest.

The agreement will allow the non-profit to work with the Forest Service on cultural heritage issues including heritage preservation programs, natural resource planning and

development and social services.

The first project will be an Elder-Youth conference set for July in Cordova. The participants will be 30 Elders and 42 youths from seven Chugach region villages.

The Forest Service will also provide information on employment possibilities.
