On March 30, the North Slope Borough Dept. of Public Safety (NSBDPS) received a report a polar bear hide and walrus head mounts were seen being taken out of the Sam and Lee's restaurant after a fire on March 29 at Barrow.

Investigation by the North Slope Borough Dept. of Public Safety showed Hyung Kim was in possession of two walrus head mounts and one polar bear hide, which were seized and turned over to the U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service (USF&W). Further investigation is being handled by the USF & W S.

On April 14, Officers Chris Dunbar and Chris Stettler of the NSBDPS responded to a report of someone importing alcohol via airplane through the airport in Anaktuvuk Pass.

They contacted Betty Kakiaya, age 34, a North Pole resident. A search warrant was served and three bottles of alcohol were seized from her luggage. Kakiaya will be summoned into court on a charge of Importation of Alcoholic Beverages into a Local Option Area.

Importation of Alcoholic Beverages into a Local Option Area is a class A Misdemeanor offense and carries with it a penalty, if convicted, of up to a \$5,000 fine and/or up to one year in jail.
