Man convicted of murder

JUNEAU – A 21-year-old Juneau man was convicted of firstdegree murder Thursday in the beating and stabbing death of an elderly woman, but a jury acquitted him of fatally stabbing her husband.

Newton Lambert sat quietly as the verdicts were read by Superior Court Judge Rodger Pegues, who later ordered that a presentence investigation be made.

A six-man, six-woman jury had deliberated two days before finding Lambert guilty of murdering Anne Benolken, 61, in April of 1982. The panel, however found him innocent of murdering her husband, James Benolken, 63.
