

Job fair set at UAF

The University of Alaska-Fairbanks' Seventh Annual Career Fair will be held Nov. 16 in Wood Center. More than 40 employers representing state and federal agencies as well as private employers will participate. The Fair will begin at 9 a.m. and close at 4 p.m.

"The Fair is designed to meet two primary goals," said Robert Egan, director of career planning and placement. "We want to acquaint our undergraduates with what employers are looking for. At the same time it is an opportunity for community adults, who are considering either career changes or returning to school, to look over the market place."

Each agency or company will have an information

booth. Representatives will staff each booth. Students and other participants will be able to visit the different booths gathering information.

A booklet outlining the needs of the employers participating in the Fair will be available. Egan suggests anyone planning on attending should pick up a copy before the Fair begins. Booklets are available in the Career Planning and Placement Center on the fifth floor of the Gruening Building.

Since the primary function of the Fair is to provide information, employers will not be interviewing for specific openings.
