There were 10 of us at the meeting from different regions. Some of them report the same problems that we on the North Slope Borough encounter such as communication problems, patient travel available now only in case of emergenting this and funding for the cies, salaries of the health aides not enough for the Other problems that face job responsibilities especially since the cutbacks could mean

less travel by health-care providers like Doctors, Publis Health Nuurses, etc.

The goals and objectives of the association in the future will be to work on reorganization, manual, training, healthcare, working conditions, salary, medical benefits, retirement, certification, communition with councils.
