

Tanana Valley Fair to Gather Schoolwork

Representatives from the Tanana Valley Fair will soon visit schools in the Fairbanks area to collect any and all kinds of schoolwork from the students for competition in the Education Division of the Fair later this summer.

Students of all ages and in any grade are encouraged to exhibit their scrapbooks, maps, penmanship, math, poetry, science work, and arts and crafts. All individual and class projects in any area are welcome.

Fair volunteers will be at the schools sometime between the 22nd and the 31 of May. Besides collecting items, they will provide entry blanks and name tags. There is no entry fee.

Qualified judges will award ribbons and cash prizes to the best entry in each section of the exhibit classes at the Fair, August 16th through 20th.

The judges will also choose exhibits to receive the Purple Championship ribbon for the best entry in each class and a Grand Championship Purple Rosette for the over-all best entry in the entire Education Division.

Last year's Fair was the largest it had ever been. By collecting early this year, the Fair will be able to make better use of the available space so that all schoolwork is exhibited in a pleasant, organized manner.

Students and parents are urged to help make this year's Education Division better than ever.
