Alaska Black Brant Wanders To Russia

JUNEAU—A black brant that was banded in Alaska wandered from its usual migration route and was shot in Russia, the Alaska Department of Fish and Game reports.

Dan Timm, waterfowl biologist for the department, said that most brant fly south to winter in Mexico and rarely fly westward over Russia.

The male bird was banded in 1963 by department biologists near Chevak on the Yukon-Kuskokwim delta. It was shot near Eguekinot, Russia on Oct. 12, 1971.

Russian officials reported the recovery of the band to the U. S. Fish and Wildlife Service which informed the Department of Fish and Game.

Timm said that about 75 per cent of all black brant in North America breed in Alaska, primarily on the Yukon-Kuskokwim delta. They gather in the Cold bay area during September and and October, then fly south to winter in Mexico.

Everyone who enters the contest will receive a button and a bumper-sticker commemorating "Get the Lead out Week" (Nov. 5-11). So no one really loses.
