

# Ralph Kowchee Art on Deer and Seal Skins Available at TT

Skin drawings by Ralph Kowchee of McGrath, Alaska are still available through the Tundra Times office. His fine drawings on deer skin and seal skin can be seen at the Tundra Times office or in the dining room of the

Petroleum Club in Fairbanks.

The drawings range from \$20 on up and cover a wide variety

of traditional Eskimo scenes. Deerskin drawings are mounted on rustic willow stretcher frames

The drawings are mainly done in black on a white skin background.

Mr. Kowchee's work has come to wide attention in Alaska. Recently, he sold one of his caribou skin drawings to Atlantic Richfield for their New York

offices.

At the present time, Mr. Kowchee is working on drawings done on the fur side of a seal skin. He has already done several experimental drawings with fine results and expects to have his first ready for sale shortly.
