

# ***Tyonek Will Carry Expenses of Housing Delegate to Wash. D.C.***

The oil-rich village of Tyonek in the Cook Inlet has announced that it will carry the transportation and living expenses of Charles Edwardson who was named an alternate delegate to Washington, D.C. at the recent Native Housing Committee meeting in Juneau.

Emil Notti and Sen. Eben Hopson had been named delegates to testify at the congressional hearings on S. 1915 which is Sen. Bartlett's bill on Native housing.

If the bill passes, it would

authorize the congress to appropriate \$10 million dollars to improve Native housing in Alaska.

Governor William Egan had told the housing committee meeting that he would furnish funds for transportation and expenses of two delegates.

The committee thought that it was important to have Edwardson go along with the delegation and decided the members would try to raise money to defray the expense of the alternate delegate.
