Alaska friends of Miss Dorothy Rae Peters will be happy to learn that although the road ahead for complete recovery is a long one, she is receiving medical care at Bethesda Naval Hospital outside Washington, D.C.

Dorothy Rae, the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Louis C. Peters, now of Seattle and formerly of Juneau, was born in Craig.

She was secretary in Senator Bartlett's office for some little time before going to Korea with the State Department. Following her duty there, Dorothy was assigned as secretary in the United States Embassy in Saigon and went to Vietnam the first part of this year. She was among those severely wounded by flying glass in the recent bombing of the Embassy there.
