

# '65 Golden Days Eskimo Olympics To Be Improved

Plans are beginning to firm up for a MAMMOTH Golden Days Celebration for the year 1965, according to Ray Hill, Chairman of the Chamber of Commerce Committee.

He announced that plans have been adopted by the committee and were approved at the last Board of Directors meeting. These plans will result in impressive and significant changes for the better in the Eskimo Olympics for this year.

Other decisions that have been made in regard to Golden Days include a final choice for a parade theme. "Golden Memories" was unanimously chosen for the 1965 parade theme by the committee.
