

Postal Facility To Be Built At Tanana

Postmaster General John A. Gronouski last Friday advised Postmaster Homer J. Doty of the Tanana, Alaska post office, that a bid has been accepted to construct a new postal facility in Tanana on First Avenue between Mill and Garden streets.

The successful bidder, Northern Commercial Company, Seattle, Washington, will construct a building containing 1,013 square feet of interior floor space, with 3,250 square feet of parking and maneuvering area.

The basic lease term will be for five years with three 5-year renewal options.
