The Alaska Division of Parks and Outdoor Recreation is now accepting applications for summer volunteer hosts for campgrounds throughout the state.

Those who enjoy camping and would like to help other campers and park visitors are encouraged to apply.

Campground hosts act as on-site representatives of the state's Division of Parks and are part of the Volunteers in Parks program. They are assigned a campsite and agree to serve a minimum of 15 days, on duty for two to five hours a day, and on call at all times.

Campground volunteers welcome campers and answer questions, acquaint visitors with activities and facilities in the park and do minor maintenance work.
