Permanent Fund applications to be delayed one week

Permanent Fund Dividend applications will be available for distribution by the U.S. Post Office April 10, according to the Alaska Department of Revenue.

The distribution is a week later than usual this year, according to Ervin Jones, director of the Permanent Fund Dividend Division. He said the printing of the booklets was delayed by changes in the Permanent Fund regulations.

Jones said the delay will not affect the starting date of the dividend payments, scheduled for October.
