

# ***Totem Heritage And Community Building***

JUNEAU — Gov. William A. Egan announced the Economic Development Administration has awarded a \$288,000 grant to the city of Ketchikan for construction of a community building and establishment of a totem heritage center.

The center will provide a museum for the display of Native artifacts, including some original totems from abandoned villages, and also will include workshop and training facilities for classes in Native arts and crafts.

Total cost of the project is \$434,000, with the city of Ketchikan providing \$146,000. The federal funds were awarded under the Public Works and Economic Development Act to stimulate long-range economic growth and to create jobs.
