

KANA to Discuss Self-Determination

The Kodiak Area Native Association (KANA) will present a discussion and initial review of Public Law 93-638, entitled the Indian Self-Determination and Education Assistance Act, at its April 18-19 Board of Directors meeting.

Ms. Ann Just of the Alaska Federation of Natives Human Resources Committee will conduct the presentation which is scheduled to begin at 2:45 p.m., Friday afternoon, April 18th.

The KANA feels this new law was primarily enacted to provide maximum participation in the Government and education of the Indian people will be of particular interest to natives enrolled to the Koniag region and extends an invitation to all to attend the meeting.

Other items on the agenda include discussions of RCA's village communications plans, native health programs, borough village planning, and bush legislation.
