

# Sealaska Plaza Building Dedication is Set for Friday

The Sealaska Plaza Building, headquarters building of the Sealaska Corporation, will be dedicated Friday afternoon in cere-

monies in Juneau which promise to draw heavy representation from the entire Alaska Native community as well as the local

populace.

The \$6 million dollar office building houses the corporate headquarters of Sealaska on the

top floor, with other occupants including the Tlingit and Haida Central Council, Alaska State Department of Labor and the

Juneau Branch of the Alaska National Bank of the North.

On the plaza level is the Sea-

laska Gallery Cultural Museum including a treasure of artifacts of the Tlingit and Haida Indians of Southeastern Alaska.

Nearly 600 Juneauites turned out June 28 to witness a ceremony in which a Haida ceremonial canoe was accepted and took its place as the star of the cultural exhibit.

The Sealaska Plaza Building and its 46,000 square feet of Class-A office space is already guaranteed 100 per cent occupancy.
